Rep. Martin Butth Sponsors Vehicle Inspection Bill

State Representative Martin D. Butth (R-Comstock Park) last week introduced a bill requiring periodic motor vehicle inspection.

According to Rep. Butth, the bill, which is sponsored by the Grand Rapids and Michigan Junior Chambers of Commerce, would be "a big step toward the reduction of the many accidents that result in death and injury in Michigan".

"Professional studies have repeatedly shown that defective vehicles are a frequent cause of accidents. For years we have passed laws requiring certain safety equipment on cars and now it seems logical that we insure that such equipment be kept in safe, working condition," he declared.

Under the bill's provisions, a Michigan driver would be required, at least once every year, to have his vehicle inspected by state-owned and operated stations in the lower half of the state or by state licensed, privately-operated stations in the upper half. The State Police would administer the program and failure to comply with the requirements would result in misdemeanor charges. The cost would not be more than two dollars per vehicle.

In introducing the bill, Butth pointed out that, besides the sponsorship of the Jaycees, the measure has the support of State Police Commissioner, Joseph Childs and Secretary of State, James Hare. "In many respects it closely resembles the proposal of Governor Romney's Special Commission on Traffic Safety," Butth added.
